Astrid: What you're searching for... isn't out there, Hiccup. She places a hand on his chest. It's in here. Maybe you just don't see it yet. Hiccup Maybe. But, y'know... there is something out there.

This Data can be classified into emotion, every person has different emotional characteristic depending on the situation. So it heavily affect the person's psychological in solving their problem. ## IV. CONCLUSION
